QUICK HITTERS

- West Virginia (11-0) picked up a 107-40 win over Longwood on Saturday in Charleston. The Mountaineers dished out 32 assists, tying for second in a single game. Tynice Martin led the way with 21 points and a career-high seven assists. Alexis Brewer also netted a career-high 16 points in the win.
- With a victory, the No. 13/12-ranked Mountaineers will conclude the nonconference slate with a 12-0 start marking the third time in program history (2002-03 and 2010-11) that WVU has finished nonleague play undefeated.
- WVU leads the country in field goal percentage defense (28.3%). Additionally, WVU is second in scoring defense (48.6 ppg) and second in blocked shots per game (7.4 bpg).
- WVU has won 31 consecutive games against nonconference opponents at the Coliseum.
- Lanay Montgomery ranks second nationally with a 74.7 field goal percentage and is fifth in the country with 3.4 blocked shots per game.

SCOUTING MOUNT

- Mount St. Mary's (2-8) has lost its last four games, including a 68-48 loss at William & Mary on Dec. 18. The Mount lost to an earlier WVU opponent, Howard, 95-62, on Dec. 10.
- Mount St. Mary's is averaging 54.2 points per game and surrendering 72.1 points per game to opponents.
- The Mountaineers are shooting 33.4 percent (176-of-527) from the field and 29.3 percent (60-of-205) from behind the arc. The Mount does not rank in any NCAA top-100 statistical category, but is second in the Northeast Conference with 130 made free throws.
- Caroline Hummell leads the Mountaineers with 11.8 points per game and is tied for the team lead with 10 steals. Mikal Johnson leads the Mount with 17 three-pointers and 12 blocks this season. Alexis Carter is Mount St. Mary's leading rebounder with 6.0 boards per game.

LAST TIME OUT

- West Virginia picked up a 107-40 win over Longwood in Charleston on Dec. 17. The Mountaineers shot 56.8 percent from the field and scored 100 points for the first time since reaching the century mark against Saint Francis in December 2014.
- WVU's 32 assists tied for second-most in a single-game and the most in the Mike Carey era. WVU made 12 three-pointers, tying for seventh all-time in a contest.
- Tynice Martin led WVU with 21 points and a career-high seven assists. Alexis Brewer reached a career-high 16 points, while Katrina Pardee dished out a career-best 10 assists.

A BLAZING START

- West Virginia's 11-0 start is the second-best in program history, surpassing a 10-0 opening to the 2002-03 season.
- West Virginia started the 2010-11 campaign with a 16-0 mark for the best opening in program history. WVU's top four starts are under coach Mike Carey.
- WVU is one of 10 DI NCAA teams still undefeated. Other teams are UConn (10-0), Virginia Tech (11-0), Oklahoma State (9-0), Maryland (11-0), Buffalo (8-0), California (10-0), Colorado (10-0), Utah (10-0) and Mississippi State (12-0).

PHYSICAL FOR 40

- West Virginia has limited its first 11 opponents this season to less than 40 percent shooting and six of those less than 30 percent: Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%), Coppin State (22.6%), NC A&T (32.2%), ECU (35.8%), Auburn (27.6%), High Point (35.6%), Morehead State (29.4%), Ole Miss (32.2%), USC Upstate (23.7%) and Longwood (23.5%).
- Through 11 games, opponents are shooting just 28.3 percent (181-of-640), which leads the NCAA in field goal percentage defense.
- WVU has converted 217 opponent turnovers (19.7 TOPG) into 249 points (22.6 ppg) this season.
- The Mountaineers have 114 steals (10.4 spg) on the season and reached double-digit steals in 7-of-11 games.
- The 11 field goals for Charleston Southern marked the 17th time in program history that WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals in a game since 2004.
- In the win over Coppin State, WVU's 14 blocks were the 10th-most in program history and the highest since deflecting 14 against Temple on April 1, 2015.
- USC Upstate's 33 points were the lowest scored for a Mountaineer opponent since Georgetown was limited to 32 points on March 4, 2012.

HARD TIME TO FIND A DIME

- West Virginia has limited 10 of its first 11 opponents to scoring less than 10 points in at least one quarter.
- The Mountaineers have held opponents under double figures in 16 quarters this season.
- The most points allowed in a quarter this season were 24 against NC A&T (Nov. 22) and Ole Miss (Dec. 4).
- ECU was limited to four points in the fourth quarter on Nov. 23, tying a record-low for points scored in a quarter by a WVU opponent.

MOUNTAINEER QUARTET

- West Virginia's three Ms (Tynice Martin, Lanay Montgomery and Teana Muldrow) along with newcomer Kristina King provide the bulk of the Mountaineers' offense with an average of 55.4 points scored per game.
- Martin leads the Big 12 with 18.7 points per game. She has reached double-figures in 13 consecutive games dating back to March 18, 2016. Martin has made a field goal in 21 consecutive games.
- Muldrow is second on the squad with 13.9 points per contest and 8.5 rebounds per game. Muldrow's rebound average is sixth in the league. Muldrow has made a field goal in 20 consecutive games.
- Montgomery is second in the Big 12 with 9.8 rebounds. She leads the league with 3.4 blocked shots per game and 4.1 offensive rebounds per game.
- Montgomery and Muldrow have combined for seven double-doubles this season, including back-to-back double-double games against High Point and Morehead State.
- Kristina King is fourth on the team with 10.7 points per game and third with 6.0 rebounds per contest.
- King has shot 58 percent or higher from the field in each of the last seven games.

STREAKS OF NOTE

- West Virginia's 11-game win streak is tied for seventh all-time. A win on Wednesday, would tie the 2014 12-game win streak for sixth.
- Lanay Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 46 of the last 49 contests.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 19 of her last 21 games, including the last 13 contests.
- Martin has made at least one try in the last six games.
- Martin has made a field goal in 21 consecutive games, while Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 20 games.

NONCONFERENCE SUCCESS

- West Virginia can close its nonconference slate undefeated with a win over Mount St. Mary's on Wednesday. With a win, the Mountaineers would finish nonleague play unbeaten for a third time in program history joining an 11-0 mark in 2002-03 and a 14-0 record in 2010-11.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the athletic communications staff.

NCAA TEAM OF THE WEEK

- WVU was named the NCAA Team of the Week on Dec. 20 for its 11-0 start.

TIME CRUNCH

- West Virginia has led for 424 minutes and 3 seconds out of 440 minutes in the first 10 games. WVU has only trailed for a total of 3:44 - :13 seconds vs. Howard; 1:35 against Auburn and :35 seconds against Morehead State; 1:21 vs. Ole Miss.

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- WVU has won a school-record 31 consecutive nonconference games inside the Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 104-7 (.937) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU's current 13-game win streak at the WVU Coliseum is tied tied with last year's 13-game win streak for the sixth-longest.
- WVU is 190-46 (.805) all-time at home under Mike Carey, including 17-0 in 2010.
- With a win on Wednesday, WVU will record its 10th undefeated season at home against nonconference competition in 16 years under Mike Carey.
- WVU has reached 10+ home wins in 11 of 15 seasons under Mike Carey.
- WVU has won 80 percent or more of its home games in seven of the last eight years.
- WVU is 395-165 (.705) at the Coliseum all-time.

- West Virginia sits in the top 15 nationally in six statistical categories.
- Through games on Dec. 18, WVU leads the country in field goal percentage defense (28.3%) and is second in scoring defense (48.6 ppg), second in blocked shots per game (7.4 bpg), third in scoring margin (+33.8), seventh in rebounding margin (+13.4), ninth in field goal percentage (48.9%) and 11th in 3-point defense (23.6%).
- Chania Ray is 28th nationally and second in the Big 12 with 5.8 assists per game.
- Tynice Martin paces the Big 12 and is 42nd in the NCAA with 18.7 points per game.
- Lanay Montgomery's 3.4 blocked shots per game are first in the league and fifth nationally.
- Montgomery's 74.7 field goal percentage ranks second nationally.
- Montgomery leads the Big 12 with 4.1 offensive rebounds per game.
- She is second in the league with 9.8 rebounds, which ranks 35th nationally.

LANAY NEARING NO. 2 IN BLOCKS

- Center Lanay Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 268 career blocked shots. She is three away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is fifth all-time in the Big 12.
- She has 733 total rebounds, which ranks 10th all-time at West Virginia.
- Additionally, Montgomery has corralled 257 career offensive rebounds, which is sixth. She is eight away from reaching the top five.
- If trends continue, Montgomery can become the Mountaineers' best shooter in program history surpassing Olayinka Sanni (55.7%). Her career field goal percentage of 58.4% currently ranks first at WVU.
- Montgomery opened her senior season with a bang, scoring 17 points and grabbing 18 rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern (Nov. 12).
- Montgomery's 17/18 performance is the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott inked 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers Feb. 1991.
- She joined Georgeann Wells (1984) as the only Mountaineers to score 20+, rebound 18+ and block 5+ in a game.
- Montgomery tallied a career-high 23 points, grabbed 18 rebounds and blocked six shots against Morehead State on Nov. 30.
- On Dec. 7, Montgomery garnered NCAA Weekly Starting Five honors for her performance against Morehead State.
- Montgomery was named a nominee for the Allstate Good Works Team on Nov. 30.

KING FINDING A RHYTHM

- Kristina King, the Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, has reached double-figure scoring in six games this season, including the last four contests. She registered 16 points in wins over East Carolina, Ole Miss and USC Upstate.
- King has grabbed five or more rebounds in nine of 11 games this season
- Also, King has shot better than 58 percent in each of the last seven games.

MARTIN ON A ROLL

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 19 of the last 21 contests, including 13 consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 16.1 points per game (339 points in 21 games).
- This season, she is averaging 18.7 points per game, which leads the Big 12.
- West Virginia is 6-0 when Martin scores 20 or more points in a game.
- She netted a career-high 28 points and matched a career-best nine field goals in the win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 22. Martin added another 27 points against Howard on Nov. 15. Martin tallied 21 points in the win over High Point (Nov. 27).
- Martin averaged 20.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the Savannah Invitational to earn MVP honors - the first regular-season tournament accolade in her career.
- Martin made 30 consecutive free throws from March 18, 2016 to Nov. 24, 2016 - the second longest streak in program history.

MAGNIFICENT MULDROW

- Junior Teana Muldrow needs 235 points to become the 33rd Mountaineer to reach the 1,000-point club.
- Muldrow ranks fourth in the Big 12 with 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Muldrow is 16th all-time at WVU with 93 made treys and needs just two more to pass Takisha Granberry for 15th.
- She is tied for 15th in career blocks (65).
- The East Orange, New Jersey, native is the active team leader with 36 games scored in double-figures.
- Muldrow added a second consecutive double-double with 18 points and 13 rebounds against Morehead State (Nov. 30).
- Muldrow earned her first career All-Tournament accolade at the Savannah Invitational.

CAREY COACHES 500TH WVU GAME

- On Nov. 27 against High Point, program all-time wins leader Mike Carey (333-171) coached his 500th game at West Virginia.
- Carey is in his 16th season at the helm of the WVU women's basketball program.
- Carey collected his 325th win at WVU with a 69-39 victory over Coppin State.
- He produced 288 wins at Salem and has 333 victories at West Virginia.
- His .661 winning percentage in 16 seasons at WVU is a program-best.
- Mike Carey (621) recorded his 600th career win at the collegiate level with WVU's 72-35 victory over Kansas on Jan. 16, 2016.
- With a win over Morehead State on Dec. 2, 2015, Carey surpassed Kittie Blakemore as WVU's all-time wins leader.

WVU utilized a 12-2 run and held CSU scoreless for a seven minute stretch that lasted late in the second quarter and the first three minutes of the third quarter. The Mountaineers are now 13-3 all-time in season openers under Mike Carey and 29-15 all-time.

Montgomery was one of three WVU players to score 17 points in the contest and did something a Mountaineer had not accomplished in 25 years. The senior from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, connected a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and added 3-of-4 from the charity stripe in 21 minutes. Montgomery's impressive 17 point and 18 rebound performance was the best for a WVU women's basketball player since Donna Abbott posted 22 points and 19 rebounds against Rutgers on Feb. 28, 1991. The double-double marked the 10th in Montgomery's career and she has now pulled down double-digit boards in back-to-back games.

Overall, West Virginia connected on 50.8 percent (32-of-63) from the field and 39.1 percent from behind the arc (9-of-23). The Mountaineers held CSU to just 17.7 percent (11-of-62) shooting, as the Buccaneers became the 17th opponent in WVU program history to only make 11 or less field goals.

West Virginia outmanned Charleston Southern, 60-31, on the boards and outscored CSU 38-2 in the paint. WVU capitalized with 21 second chance points and 24 points off 16 Buccaneers turnovers.

Junior Teana Muldrow scored 17 points, collected seven rebounds, dished out three assists and snatched a pair of steals. Tynice Martin also eclipsed double figures with 17 points, making 7-of-13 from the field and 3-of-7 from the 3-point line.

Chania Ray distributed a career-high 11 assists - the most for a Mountaineer point guard since Linda Stepany recorded 12 against Saint Francis in Dec. 2014. Ray also registered four rebounds and two steals.

A couple of other Mountaineers reach career highs: Anja Martin tallied a personal-best eight points and Desiree Rhodes corralled a new career-high in 12 boards. Kristina King, the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year, scored eight points in her WVU debut.

Montgomery's Career-High 27 Paces WVU Past Howard

Sophomore Tynice Martin netted a career-high 27 points to lead the No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a 95-49 victory over Howard on Tuesday evening at the WVU Coliseum.

Howard senior Te'Shya Heslip's layup cut the WVU lead to 16-11 with 1:41 remaining in the first quarter. However, West Virginia answered with a 21-0 run that lasted six minutes into the second quarter.

The Mountaineers (2-0) tallied 54 of their 95 points in the second half to cruise to their 26th consecutive victory against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum.

Martin bested her previous career-high of 20 points and became the ninth WVU player to finish perfect from the free throw line with 10 or more points. The sophomore from Atlanta finished the evening 7-of-14 from the field, 3-of-9 from behind the arc and 10-of-10 from the free throw line. She grabbed four rebounds, collected three steals, dished out two assists and blocked two shots in 29 minutes.

In addition to Martin, four other Mountaineers eclipsed double-figures. Junior Chania Ray netted a career-best 17 points, going 7-of-14 from the field, while dishing out five assists and snatching a career-high five steals.

Alexis Brewer connected on a career-best three triples and finished 5-of-9 with 13 points. Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year Kristina King tallied 12 points and corralled six rebounds. Teana Muldrow finished with 11 points, eight rebounds four assists and three steals. Lanay Montgomery blocked a shot for a 26th straight game and registered her third consecutive double-figure rebounding game with a game-high 13 boards. The senior scored seven points, just three shy of a double-double.

Overall, WVU shot 46.3 percent (31-of-67) from the field and 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from behind the arc. From the charity stripe, WVU knocked down 23-of-29 free throw attempts for 79.3 percent. Howard was limited to 32.0 percent shooting (16-of-51) from the field and 3-of-15 (20.0 percent) from behind the arc. The Mountaineers won the rebound battle, 48-28 and outscored Howard 32-18 in the paint. WVU forced 27 Howard turnovers and converted those into 34 points.

WVU Clips Eagles to Complete Homestand

Three players reached double-figures in the West Virginia University women's basketball team's 69-39 victory over Coppin State on Saturday.

No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia (3-0) opened the game on a 10-0 run, but shot just 33.3 percent (11-of-33) in the opening half. For a third consecutive game, the Mountaineers bounced back and shot over 60 percent (8-of-13) in the third quarter and took command of the contest for the team's 27th consecutive win at the WVU Coliseum against nonconference opponents. With the loss, Coppin State fell to 0-4 on the year.

Sophomore Tynice Martin led all scorers with 19 points. Martin connected on six field goals and connected on a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. The Atlanta native has now made 19 consecutive free throws dating back to the Princeton game on March 18, 2016, last season.

Katrina Pardee finished with a season-high 17 points and registered a career-high six rebounds in 29 minutes. Teana Muldrow tallied 11 points and pulled down seven rebounds for fourth consecutive double-figure scoring game. The junior made 5-of-8 from the field, snatched three steals and blocked two shots.

Lanay Montgomery had her best blocking performance since April 2015, leading the way with seven of WVU's 14 blocks on the evening. Montgomery also tallied seven points and grabbed seven rebounds. Chania Ray led WVU with eight assists, while grabbing seven rebounds and collecting three steals.

Overall, West Virginia shot 40.0 percent (24-of-60) from the field and 21.7 percent (5-of-23) from behind the three-point line. Coppin State became the fourth consecutive WVU opponent to shoot below 40 percent, connecting on just 22.6 percent (14-of-62) from the field and 9.1 percent (1-of-11) from behind the arc.

West Virginia opened the first quarter on a 10-0 run. However, Coppin State answered with a 7-4 run to close Mountaineer lead to 14-7 at the end of one.

Despite shooting just 25 percent (4-of-16) in the first quarter, the Mountaineers answered in the second quarter by connecting on 7-of-17 for 41.2 percent. WVU used a 13-0 run over a four minute span to push its lead to 24 points with four minutes remaining in the opening half. Pardee paced WVU with 10 points followed by eight from Martin. Muldrow connected on nine of WVU's first 11 points to open the third quarter. West Virginia outscored CSU, 22-14, and held a 55-27 advantage after three periods. The Mountaineers added 14 more points in the fourth quarter to secure their ninth win over Coppin State.

WVU Downs High Point for 7-0 Start

Four Mountaineers eclipsed double-figures with Tynice Martin's 21 points leading the way in the No. 19/23-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team's 82-59 victory over High Point on Sunday at the WVU Coliseum.

A high-scoring first quarter saw the Mountaineers hold a slight 28-22 edge. The team built its halftime advantage to 45-31. West Virginia led the entire game and stretched its lead to 25 points in the fourth quarter. WVU improved to 7-0, the program's best start since the 2010-11 season, and extended its program-record nonconference win streak at the WVU Coliseum to 28.

Martin made 10-of-20 from the field to finish with 21 points, four assists and four steals. The performance was Martin's third 20-point game of the season and her ninth consecutive game in double-figure scoring.

Lanay Montgomery had a standout performance, registering her second double-double this season and the 11th of her career, with 15 points and 14 rebounds. Montgomery blocked five shots, dished out three assists and snatched two steals in 31 minutes. Teana Muldrow also recorded a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

Overall, West Virginia made 33-of-66 from the field for 50 percent shooting and held its eighth consecutive opponent to less than 40 percent shooting as High Point shot at a 35.6 percent (21-of-59) clip. From three-point range, WVU connected on 5-of-17 for 29.4 percent compared to HPU's 5-of-14 for 35.7 percent. The Mountaineers matched a season-high with 20 assists.

Defensively, West Virginia netted a season-high 16 steals and blocked eight shots. The Mountaineers converted 24 High Point turnovers into 27 points.

West Virginia opened the game to a 9-3 advantage, capitalizing on four early High Point miscues. The Panthers battled back to trim the game to an 11-9 WVU edge after a 6-2 spurt. A Kristina King layup pushed WVU's lead to 23-10 with 2:11 remaining in the period. HPU closed the period on a 12-5 run to narrow the gap to 28-22.

Ray's three-pointer at 6:30 extended the Mountaineer lead to 14, capping a 9-1 WVU run to open the second quarter. Just a minute later, High Point narrowed the lead to 10 points. However, West Virginia maintained a 14-point cushion with a 45-31 halftime advantage.

Martin and Muldrow combined for 12 of West Virginia's first 14 points in the third quarter. A jumper by Martin with 5:53 remaining pushed the Mountaineer lead to 23. Katrina Pardee's jumper gave WVU a 63-43 edge at the end of three. Pardee would finish with nine points.

WVU scored its first eight points from the free throw line the fourth quarter until a Martin jumper at 5:06. The Mountaineers outpaced HPU 19-16 in the frame.

Montgomery Moves WVU Past Morehead State

A stellar performance from senior center Lanay Montgomery propelled the No. 16/17-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a 94-53 victory over Morehead State on Wednesday at the WVU Coliseum.

West Virginia held an early eight-point advantage, but MSU's Katelyn Byrd made a triple with 3:09 remaining in the first quarter to give Morehead State a 15-14 lead. Montgomery's layup 35 seconds later sparked a 13-0 Mountaineer run. Later in the second quarter, WVU used a Montgomery layup and a Katrina Pardee three-pointer to jump start a 17-0 spurt. West Virginia (8-0) scored its second-most points of the season and rolled to a 29th consecutive win against nonconference competition at the WVU Coliseum. Morehead State's two-game win streak was snapped, as the Eagles fell to 5-3 on the season.

Montgomery's historic performance included a career-high 23 points, matching a season-high 18 rebounds and blocking six shots in 25 minutes. She made 10-of-11 field goal attempts for 90.9 percent shooting from the field. The Pittsburgh native was just the second WVU player in history to score at least 20-plus points, grab at least 18-plus rebounds and block five or more shots. Only WVU Hall of Famer Georgeann Wells had a better performance against Marshall in 1984, scoring 35 points, pulling down 19 rebounds and blocking eight shots. The double-double was the third for Montgomery this year and the 12th of her career.

Teana Muldrow also netted her third double-double this season with 18 points and 13 rebounds. The junior matched a career-high four assists, blocked three shots and collected three steals. Montgomery and Muldrow are the first WVU duo to tally double-doubles in back-to-back games since Liz Repella and Takisha Granberry accomplished the feat versus FIU and NJIT in November 2008.

Tynice Martin reached double-figure scoring for a 10th consecutive game with 17 points. Also in double-figures, Kristina King posted 14 and grabbed seven rebounds.

West Virginia shot 47.4 percent (36-of-76) from the field and 41.2 percent (7-of-17) from behind the arc. The Mountaineers held their ninth consecutive opponent to less than 40 percent shooting and their fourth opponent this season to less than 30 percent shooting, as Morehead State was limited to 29.4 percent (20-of-68) from the field.

In the rebound column, WVU grabbed 59 boards compared to MSU's 43. The Mountaineers blocked a season-best 15 shots, the most since deflecting 15 against Kansas State on Jan. 21, 2015. WVU also matched a season-high with 20 assists.

WVU Women's Hoops Improve to 10-0

The No. 13/14-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team shot a season-high 59.7 percent from the field and improved to 10-0 in a 91-33 victory over USC Upstate on Saturday.

West Virginia opened the contest on an 11-2 run and never trailed. The Mountaineers used a 21-0 scoring spurt in the third and fourth quarters to pick up their 31st consecutive win over a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum. WVU's 12th straight win at the Coliseum ranks seventh all-time, while the 10-game win streak is tied for the 10th longest in program history. Saturday's win also tied the Mountaineers second-best start in program history, matching the 10-0 start in 2002-03. USC Upstate's 33 points were the lowest for a Mountaineer opponent since Georgetown was limited to 32 in 2012. The Spartans fell to 4-6 on the season.

Senior center Lanay Montgomery recorded her fourth double-double of the year with 16 points and 10 rebounds. She blocked four shots and made 8-of-9 from the field for an 88.9 shooting percentage. For a second consecutive game, Kristina King matched season-highs with 16 points and nine rebounds in 19 minutes. Teana Muldrow finished with 15 points, six rebounds and five assists. Additionally, Tynice Martin eclipsed double-figures for a 12th consecutive game with 14 points.

Chania Ray finished with nine points and led WVU with seven assists and four steals. Sophomore Katrina Pardee also tallied nine points in the contest.

West Virginia limited its 11th consecutive opponent to less than 40 percent shooting as USC Upstate made just 14-of-59 for 23.7 percent. WVU dished out 24 assists and collected 14 steals in the victory.

Pardee scored West Virginia's first seven points as the Mountaineers opened the contest to an 11-2 lead. Montgomery also added eight points and blocked two shots in seven minutes in the opening quarter.

Six of the first eight points were scored by the USC Upstate to start the second quarter. Montgomery, King and Pardee sparked a 10-3 Mountaineer run. West Virginia closed the half with a 42-19 lead and shot a season-best 63.3 percent from the field in the opening half.

Muldrow made four of West Virginia's first six points in the second half, all of which came from the charity stripe. The Mountaineers closed the third quarter on a 14-point run to extend the margin to 45 points.

WVU added seven more consecutive points to stretch the lead to 79-26 with 7:40 remaining. A layup from Vanessa Agrusa snapped the 21-0 run, but WVU added 13 more points in the quarter for its largest margin of victory win of the season. Brittney Delva led the Spartans with 12 points.

WVU Dishes Out 32 Assists in Win over Longwood

The No. 14-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team tied a school-record 32 assists in a 107-40 victory over Longwood on Saturday afternoon at the Charleston Civic Center.

A 16-4 run and another 16-0 spurt in the first quarter set the tone for the Mountaineers. West Virginia shot 71.4 percent (25-of-35) in the first half. Although WVU (11-0) cooled down in the second half, the Mountaineers finished the game shooting 56.8 percent (42-of-74) from the field. WVU's 32 assists on 42 field goals matched 32 assists dished out against Indiana State (Nov. 23, 1984) and Duquesne (Nov. 7, 1984). Longwood fell to 1-7 on the season.

Tynice Martin led the Mountaineers with 21 points for her sixth career 20-point performance. Martin dished out a career-high seven assists and matched a season-high six rebounds. Lanay Montgomery made 9-of-9 from the field and finished with 19 points, eight rebounds and three blocks. Junior guard Teana Muldrow also went a perfect 7-of-7 from the field to finishing the day with 17 points, while dishing out five assists and grabbing four rebounds.

Alexis Brewer eclipsed double figures with a career-high 16 points in 28 minutes. Kristina King rounded out WVU's double-digit scoring with 11 points, and sophomore Katrina Pardee led the team with a career-high 10 assists and zero turnovers in 21 minutes. Desiree Rhodes paced the team with nine rebounds.

Saturday's victory gave West Virginia its 11th straight win, tying for the seventh-longest win streak and second-best start to a season in program history. Longwood became the Mountaineers' 12th consecutive opponent to shoot less than 40 percent from the field, knocking down just 23.5 percent (12-of-51). West Virginia won the rebound battle, 49-28, and outscored the Lancers, 40-12, in the paint. WVU converted 24 Longwood turnovers into 29 points. WVU's 107-point performance was the most since tallying 109 against Delaware State on Dec. 18, 2013.

West Virginia opened the game with four different Mountaineers making three-pointers to put WVU up 16-4 with 6:31 left in the first quarter. The team capped a 16-0 run in the first quarter and led 31-8, marking the 15th time this season WVU has limited its opponents to under double-figure scoring in a quarter.
